# **2018 Montgomery County 4-H Summer Adventures**



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**4-H Summer Adventures** is a special program sponsored by Montgomery County 4-H through NC Cooperative Extension. Activities are open to all youth ages 5-19. Workshops are designed for specific age groups and there are limited spaces. (*Please do not register your child for a class that is not for their age*). We invite you to join us for a fun and exciting time. You do not have to be a 4-H member to participate.

To enroll in 4-H Summer Adventures, you must **complete a registration form**, **available at the 4-H office**, along with a Code of Conduct, Medical Release and Photo Consent. Payment should be made at the time of registration. Cash and checks made payable to Montgomery County 4-H will be accepted. One registration form per participant, please. Please note that these must be completed yearly. There is no fee to join 4-H but there is a one time fee of \$10 per participant for Summer Adventures registration which covers the cost of a t-shirt, snacks and insurance for each class.

Registration for interested individuals will be open on Wednesday, May 23rd from Noon—5 PM and on Thursday, May 24th from 9 AM—6 PM. We will continue to accept registration after this date until each class is full. Please take advantage of the scheduled registration dates to ensure your child's space in the classes of their choice.

Registration will be accepted at the NC Cooperative Extension Office located at 203 West Main Street, Troy. No registration for Summer Adventures will be accepted over the telephone. There are no refunds unless the class is canceled.

### 4-H Teen Fun Day

Participants will travel to Wet'n Wild Emerald Pointe, where they will learn about water safety and how to stay safe in the summer heat. Then they will spend the rest of the day exploring the water park. Be sure to bring plenty of sunscreen, water shoes, and towels. Girls will be required to wear a tankini or one piece bathing suit. Lunch will be provided. Date: June 11th. Time: 8 am -5 pm. Ages 12 and up. Cost \$35.00.

#### Farm to Fork

Participants will tour local Livestock and Produce farms to learn first hand how their food is produced. They will learn how to cook locally sourced ingredients. NO OPEN TOED SHOES! Dates: June 12th—14th. Time: 8:30 am—Noon each day. Ages: 13-18. Cost: \$30 each.

Come join us and learn how to have fun no matter what age you are. Volunteers from the Montgomery County Senior Center will provide instruction on disc golf, shuffleboard, bocce, and horse shoes. Date: June 20th. Time: 8:30 am -4:30 pm. Ages 8 and up. Cost: \$5.00
